Our BioFire Analyzer for in-Hospital COVID-19 testing arrived this week. Staff training will take place. This machine is new to the Health Centre and new to Canada. While it is FDA approved we expect Health Canada to approve it shortly. Our analyzer provides medical teams with testing results in under an hour. Thank you to Goodfellows Masonic Lodge and the Waubuno Shrine Club for the \$50,000 gift to purchase.

## Emergency Department Changes During our COVID-19 Response Planning:

After successfully testing the COVID-19 Response Plan, our Emergency Department now triages as follows:

- · All patients seeking care in the Emergency Department will be directed to stop at the tent for pre-triage assessment.
- · Patients who present with fever or respiratory symptoms will be directed into one stream. All other patients will move along a separate care path.
- Patients in the two streams will be triaged and provided with care in separate locations: ED and Ambulatory Care.
- Though in some ways similar to our summer-surge Non-urgent Care Clinic, we are NOT operating on that basis. We must rely on the public to ONLY VISIT our ED when in need of urgent care.
- · Yellow footprints installed on the lobby floor will help to guide patients.

## To Mask or Not to Mask, that is No Longer the Question.

We can continue to flatten the curve but the public remains the first line of defense. Please:

- · if arriving from outside the community, quarantine for 14 days
- · continue to stay home as much as possible
- · practise physical distancing of at least 6 feet when in public
- · regularly wash your hands or use alcohol-based sanitizers,
- · don't touch your face
- · cover your cough or sneeze, and
- · send only 1 family member to our stores for essentials.

Added now is wearing a 'home-made' mask while in stores. This does not replace physical distancing it enhances the safety physical distancing provides.

Organized by our Health Centre Auxiliary, sewers throughout Parry Sound area are creating masks for broader public use. The mask distribution plan is being finalized. All masks are being cleaned at the Health Centre, then will be paper-bagged (off site) two per bag along with some instruction. The bags will then move north, south, and east. All as long as supplies last. As it stands today:

- · Masks in Production.
- · Distribution System in the works.
- · Details on the 'supply chain' to follow when confirmed.
